About the Course

The Practitioner Examination Preparation event provides an opportunity to apply learning of the PRINCE2 methodology to various project scenarios. The scenarios used on this event are in the same format to those used in the official AXELOS Practitioner Exam. The focus of this event is to apply previous learning of the method to sample Practitioner style exam questions. No learning of any new PRINCE2 topics should be expected, rather an enhancement of your existing knowledge. Course Approach

During the course, candidates will have an opportunity to try out the application of their 'existing' PRINCE2® knowledge to a typical practitioner exam scenario and related objective tests questions with feedback from an approved trainer.

It can be expected that this preparation event will improve the likelihood of passing the AXELOS Ltd Practitioner Exam. However, success in the exam requires some basic analytical skills under time pressure, and this event is not intended to provide anything other than a high-level appreciation of these important skills, together with some exam strategy advice and guidance.


Practitioner: 21/2 hours, 'open book' (official PRINCE2® manual only) exam, consisting of 68 scenario-based objective test questions.

Course Coverage





- An overview of the PRINCE2® Practitioner Exam, including structure/format, syllabus areas, question types and the importance of strategy and time management.
- Then, for each syllabus area (for example 'Principles', 'Business Case', 'Quality', 'Risk') sample Practitioner Exam questions will be set. As each syllabus area is completed, there will be a review of the answers and rationale, before moving on to another syllabus area. This cycle is then repeated throughout the day. In order to ensure that delegates are well prepared for the Practitioner Exam, all syllabus areas are covered, including a look at key areas of the manual (bearing in mind that the Practitioner Exam is 'open-book').

By the end of the day, delegates will have attempted sample questions covering all Practitioner syllabus areas and question types used in the Practitioner Exam, with some further questions being available for evening work.

Following this event, delegates should feel thoroughly prepared for the Practitioner Exam, which will normally be taken on the morning following this 1-day event.
