Entry Requirements

The British Sign Language Level 1 Award can be taken without previous BSL experience. Learners will acquire basic skills and confidence in the two areas of production and reception of BSL.



Assessment

To be successful in the course, candidates must pass all units. Learners who are new to BSL should cover Unit 101 first. Units 102 and 103 can be taken in any order. Unit BSL101 is internally assessed by the teacher, while Units 102 and 103 are externally assessed by a Signature assessor.



Achievement

Upon successful completion, learners will be awarded the British Sign Language Level 1 Award by Signature.

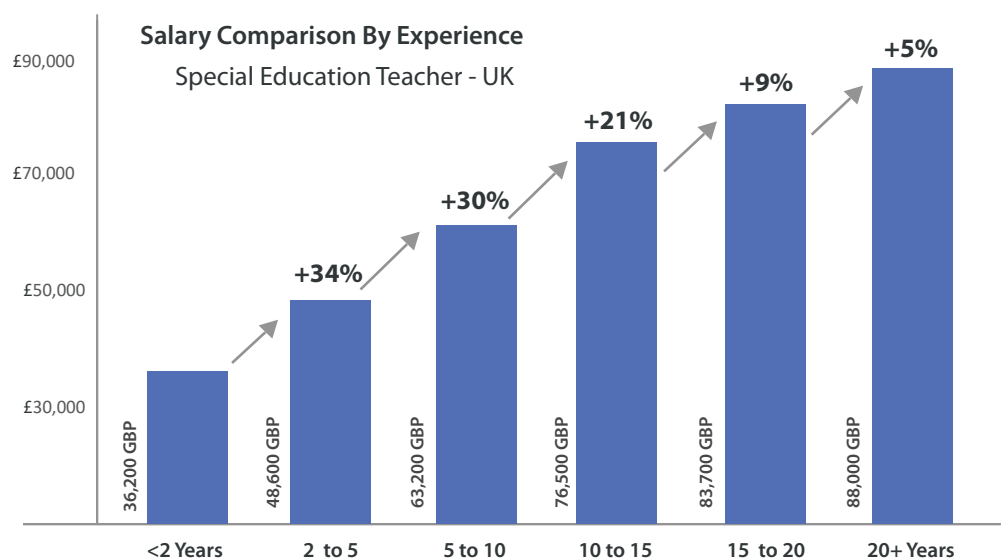


Career Path

Once you successfully qualify for the British Sign Language Level 1 Award, learners can confidently communicate with deaf people in BSL. The qualification is supported by over 500 centres in the United Kingdom from schools, academics, and higher education establishments. Your skills will give you a generous-paying job, plenty of benefits, and a wide array of opportunities.

What is Next ?

You will receive a qualification that builds on your basic skills and confidence in the production and reception of BSL. On completion of the BSL Level 1 Award, learners can progress to the Level 2 and Level 3 British Sign Language Certificates. The qualifications have the potential to open up exciting employment opportunities for the learner across a wide spectrum.



Building on Your Qualification

British Sign Language was officially recognised by the UK Government in 2003 as a minority language. The language has its own syntax and grammatical structure and is used primarily by people who are deaf or have hearing impairments. The range of qualifications in BSL has led individuals towards qualified status as sign language interpreters or a career working with deaf people.

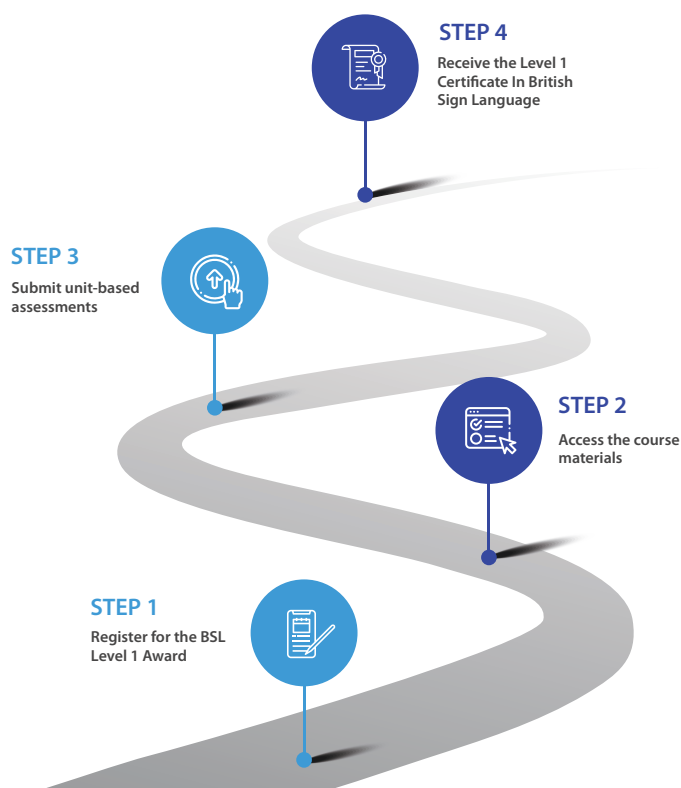
