The TQUK Level 5 TEFL Certificate in Teaching English as a Foreign Language (RQF) is a standalone qualification that provides all the in-depth skills you need to teach English as a second language.

This qualification is regulated by Ofqual (The Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation). This means that the UK government has approved the qualification, considering it equivalent to the following: a diploma of higher education (DipHE), a foundation degree, 2 years at university and the CELTA and Trinity CertTESOL qualifications.
