

Course Overview

The Level 3 Applied General Certificate in Business and Enterprise is specifically designed for those who want to study enterprise and business at a medium. This qualification enables the learners to develop understanding, knowledge, and skills in the business and enterprise sector. It is suitable for learners who want to continue their education through applied learning, arming them with transferable skills and knowledge. This course also does provide UCAS points.

Eligibility Criteria

For entry into this course, students must meet the following criteria:

- •This course is offered to students that are 16 and over. We do not specify learning requirements for this qualification.
- We ensure that students admitted to the program have the capability to undertake the assessment and learning criteria.
- ●Learners enrolled in this qualification have no right to undertake another same level qualification with a similar title; a duplication of learning may affect learner's funding eligibility.
- This qualification is offered in English.

English language requirement

Learners are expected to have English language proficiency of CEFR Level B2, this can be met in any one the following ways:

- 1. Being a native English language speaker
- 2. Having achieved IELTS 5.5 or equivalent
- 3. Having done your last two years of schooling in English
- 4. Passing our online English language test

Duration and Delivery

This course is designed to be completed over two-years of full-time study. However, we provide flexible time duration in delivery to accommodate distance and part-time learning. The qualification is delivered through the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE).

Assessment & Verification

All units within this course are internally analysed by our internal assessors and externally verified by NCFE. This course is criterion-referenced, based on specific learning outcomes. Each unit is graded using the following structure; Not Yet Achieved, Pass, Merit, and Distinction.

Progression

Successful completion of the course enables the learners to get direct entry into the Level 2 Diploma in Skills for business, Certificate in Digital Promotion for Business, Certificate in Business and Enterprise, and a certificate in creating a Business Start-Up. This qualification fulfills the entry requirements for higher education courses at the same level. Possible degree course progressions include Accounting, Finance, HR, Politics, Marketing, and Business Studies. Completion will also give learners UCAS points, depending on your grade. Learners get: 16 for a pass, 32 for a merit, 48 for a distinction, and 56 for a distinction*.
